### CRUISE RATES INCLUDE

### CABIN CATEGORIES

#### DOLPHIN DECK

Cabins #1,3 & 4 have two twin lower beds or one double bed and picture windows.

Cabin # 2 has one double bed and picture window.  
(cabins average 95 square feet/ 8.8 square meters)

#### BOOBY DECK

Cabins # 5 & 6 cabins have one double bed and picture windows.  
(cabins average 90 square reef/ 8.4 square meters)

#### IGUANA DECK

Cabins #7 & 8 have two twin lower beds and port lights.  
Cabins # 9 & 10 have two twin lower beds and one upper berth with port lights and can be sold as triples. (cabins average 110 square feet/ 10.2 square meters)

### CRUISE RATES DO NOT INCLUDE

International Airfare to Ecuador - you must arrive to Quito or Guayaquil the day prior to the cruise

Hotel accommodation in Ecuador the night before your cruise - we can assist with your reservation

Airfare from Quito or Guayaquil to Galapagos - your flight is confirmed through our allotment of seats with Avianca on Sunday to San Cristobal (SCY) \*

Galapagos Park entrance fee (park tax) - \$100 for adults \$50 for children 11 and under

Migration control Transit card (TCT or INGALA) fee \$20 per person

Gratuities to guides and crew - For those who inquire, the suggested amount is \$250-300 per guest per week

Purchases from the bar for wine and spirits or purchases from the boutique.

We accept cash (US Dollars), Master Card and VISA

Travel Insurance - recommended to protect your travel investment in case of cancellation or delays

**Wet suits by Scuba Pro** - available to use during the cruise at no additional charge on a first come first serve basis. Guests who would like to reserve a wet suit may do so at a charge of \$25 per wet suit on Letty. The fee will be charged to the account on board and paid at the end of the cruise. Reserved wet suits will be removed from the inventory in your closest approximate size and set aside for your exclusive use during the cruise. Mens: S, M, MT, L, XL, XXL, XXXL/ Womens: S, M, MT, L, XL/ Children: 10 (S), 12 (M), 14 (L)

**Communication** - The Letty does not offer Wi-Fi. Most telecommunication providers do have a signal in Galapagos and guests can use their mobile/cellular phones that are activated for international calling on most days during the week when the yachts are in close range to port.

\*AIRFARE and FLIGHT SCHEDULE to Galapagos - Flights to Galapagos for Ecoventura passengers are serviced by AVIANCA Airlines from Quito (UIO) and Guayaquil (GYE) to Galapagos (San Cristobal = SCY). Flight reservations for confirmed passengers are made automatically through our seat allotment with Avianca. All passengers who arrive to SCY on AV 1636 on Sunday will receive assistance with the check in procedure and the option to pre-pay the transit card fee. A representative from Ecoventura accompanies our passengers on this flight. Upon arrival, our crew and guides meet this flight and transport passengers to the yachts. Passengers who chose to arrive on any other flight will not be provided with the same services.

### Surcharges & discounts

Holiday weeks (Dec 20-27-A Dec 27-03 Jan-B) – supplement of \$250 per person or \$5,000 on charters

No discounts are available including child and teen discounts. The single rate has 100% supplement. Terms for deposits and cancellation during holiday weeks are different from the rest of the year.

### 7 day/ 6 night cruise option (Sunday to Saturday)

Passengers can disembark on Saturday in Baltra for a shorter, 6-night cruise. On seasonal departure dates only, there is a discount of 10% given when guests disembark after breakfast and this cannot be combined with any other promotional or child/teen discount. On peak weeks, passengers may disembark on Saturday, but there is no discount. For guests who require a private transfer

to the airport with a guide, there is an additional charge of \$50 per person (max \$200). The return flight from Baltra has a surcharge of \$27 per person and is subject to availability and confirmation is requested at the time of booking.

### Two weeks back to back – itinerary A & B combined

Book two consecutive weeks back-to-back and take a 5% discount on both weeks on seasonal departure dates and on the second week only on peak departures.

### Two week combination with Galapagos Sky dive liveboard

Take 5% discount when booked in combination with one week on Sky back to back.

**Two-week/ back-to-back discounts cannot be combined with any other discount and does not apply to holiday weeks.**

**Child and teen discounts** – children age 11 years and younger at the time of sailing are entitled to a 25% discount off the cruise rate. The airfare has 30% discount and the park entrance fee is \$50 with proof of age and photocopy of the child's passport showing date of birth. Children ages 12-17 years are entitled to a 15% discount off the cruise rate only. Children under age 6 years of age are not accepted unless the parents or legal guardians sign a hold harmless release. Children age 11 and younger are only permitted only on a designated family departure. Designated family and family teen departures are offered during school breaks. Children under the age of 5 are only permitted on exclusive charter basis.

**Restrictions on child discounts** - We allow one child discount per every adult fare with a limit of two per family. Ecoventura may limit the total number of child discounts permitted on any one departure. Children under 18 years must be accompanied by an adult. No child discounts are given on holiday weeks.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

All reservations are subject to cancellation if payments are not received in our account by the due date.

There is a service charge of \$50.00 per person for airline tickets to Galapagos cancelled 15-60 days prior to departure and there is no refund for the airfare, park entrance fee or transit card if cancelled 15 days or less prior to departure.

Individual (FIT) bookings (1-5 passengers)

**Deposits** - A deposit of \$500 per person and \$1000 for singles is required within five days of written confirmation to guarantee any reservation.

**Final payment** - Full payment is due 60 days prior to the sailing date and must be accompanied with a passenger information form.

**Cancellation policy** - Cancellations received up to 90 days prior to departure will be refunded in full except for a \$250 per person service charge; 89-60 days prior to departure, the full deposit will be forfeited, 59-0 days prior to departure, the entire cruise rate is forfeited.

Small Group bookings (3 or more cabins)

**Deposits & Final payment** – same as above. In addition, a second deposit of \$500 per person and \$1000 for singles is due 180 days prior to departure.

**Cancellation policy** - Cancellations received up to 180 days prior to departure will be refunded in full except for a \$250 per person service charge; 179-150 days prior to departure - Can cancel 2 cabins with a penalty of \$250 per person, additional cabins released are subject to penalty charge of \$500 per person.

149-120 days prior to departure - Can cancel 1 cabin with a penalty of \$250 per person, additional cabins released are subject to a penalty of \$500 per person 119-90 days prior to departure – any cancellation is subject to a penalty of \$500 per person. 89-60 days prior to departure – any cancellation is subject to a penalty of \$1000 per person 59-0 days prior to departure – full penalty for any cancellation

### CHARTER Bookings – excluding holiday weeks

**Deposits** - A deposit of \$10,000 is due to guarantee the charter. A second deposit of \$10,000 is due 180 days prior to departure to guarantee all cabins. Final payment is due in full at 60 days prior to departure together with passenger information forms and cabin assignment.

**Full charter Cancellation policy** - Cancellations received in writing will be refunded - except for a service charge of \$2500 if cancelled one year or more prior to departure, \$5000 if cancelled 9-12 months prior, or \$7500 if cancelled 6-9 months prior.

179-150 days prior to departure, cancellation incurs penalty of 100% first deposit.

149-120 days prior to departure, cancellation incurs penalty of 100% first deposit and 50% of second deposit.

119-60 days prior to departure, cancellation incurs penalty of 100% of the first and second deposits.

59-0 days of departure cancellation incurs full penalty.

**Reduction of cabins on charters** - The number of cabins blocked for a charter can be reduced. However, cabins must be released according to our time schedule or penalties will be applied as follows:

180+ days prior to departure - Can release up to 3 cabins without a penalty and convert the charter to a group booking, additional cabins released are subject to a penalty of \$250 per person.

179-150 days prior to departure- Can release up to 2 cabins with a penalty of \$250 per person, additional cabins released are subject to penalty charge of \$500 per person.

149-120 days prior to departure- Can release 1 cabin with a penalty of \$250 per person, any additional cabins released are subject to penalty charge of \$500 per person.

119-90 days prior to departure - Any cancellation is subject to a penalty of \$500 per person.

89-60 days prior to departure – any cancellation is subject to a penalty of \$1000 per person

59-0 days prior to departure – full penalty for any cancellation
