MOUNTAIN LODGES OF PERU El Retablo—NEW property in Cusco

As of 15th December 2016, Mountain Lodges of Peru will launch a new boutique hotel called "El Retablo", a 17-room mid/upscale property, located 2 blocks from Plaza Nazarenas (location of Monasterio, Palacio Nazarenas & Inkaterra La Casona) in the city of Cusco. El Retablo will have 2 types of rooms; Superior & Superior Deluxe and it will be positioned as the best 3 star option in Cusco!

In terms of architecture and interior design, it will be a concept boutique hotel, similar to El Mercado. **Retablos** are a sophisticated Andean folk art in the form of portable boxes which depict religious, historical, or everyday events that are important to the Indigenous people of the highlands of Peru and Bolivia. The first retablos were placed on or behind the altars of Catholic churches in Spain and Latin America. They were three-dimensional statues or images inside a decorated frame. Later, retablos evolved to include daily scenes in the lives of the Andean people, such as harvests, processions, feasts, and tableaux depicting shops and homes.


